	vinyl and nitril gloves – your size and some large size if different (*)	various size safety pins
	surgical masks (*)	Misc. supplies
	plastic (food service type) apron (make from feed bags?)	Betadine solution – povidone-iodine. – surgical prep
	eye protection	single use vials of lidocaine
	Cleaning supplies	booklet showing surgical knots
	sm. bottle of surgical (green) soap or plain dish soap	bottled drinking water, electrolyte solution concentrate (*)
	fingernail brush	protein/energy bars
